PREMIER PROGRAMS

HEAR THIS Poetry/Literacy & Mentorship Program A school & community based program that utilizes performance poetry, music production, and visual arts workshops delivered by professional artists/mentors to help youth develop a lifelong love of self-expression & literacy presented virtually & inperson.

YOUTH POET LAUREATE TWP is part of the National Youth Poet Laureate Program. It is presented in collaboration with Urban Word, New York City, PEN Center USA, the Academy of American Poets, and Virginia Humanities. Includes the Hampton Roads Youth Poet Laureate and the Virginia Youth Poet Laureate.

HAMPTON ROADS YOUTH POETRY FESTIVAL Olympic style competition showcases the creativity of poets and emerging world changers. The winners form an elite group called Hampton Roads Youth Poets who participate in the Write to the City National Youth Poetry Camp in Chicago and Brave New Voices International Poetry Festival Competition.


PURPOSE PLACE TEEN GATHERINGS After-school program including tutoring; homework assistance; peer leadership; gardening; Youth Circle Conflict Resolution and Problem Solving Sessions; Poetry; Music Production; Visual Arts; Teen Radio Show; Yoga; and guest speakers discussing healthy life and career choices. Transportation and meals provided.

TEEN LED CAMPS Summer camps & Spring Break Camps Trained teen leaders are hired to help facilitate the sessions. Each camp offers an array of experiences both in house workshops with professionals & peer leaders includes field trips, hands on learning arts, boat building, glassblowing and other sports and crafts.

SAFE CREATIVE COMMUNITY SPACE & HORTICULTURAL INTERNSHIP PROGRAM TWP Horticultural Internship Program (H.I.P.) launched September 2018 to provide young people living in the St. Paul's Quadrant with the tools to develop healthier lifestyles and workforce skills. They become producers able to plant and harvest an abundance of food that is continuously available to their families and community.

F.U.S.E. FESTIVAL 2022 marks the 10th annual FUSE Festival, an interactive, transformative community festival, bringing love, arts and change to Norfolk. FUSE FEST, held at Pur-pose Park Safe Creative Community Space (SCS), celebrates community, igniting hope to dismantle negative attitudes, beliefs and unhealthy practices held by and about the St. Paul's Quadrant.

PEER LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT Youth develop and prac-tice leadership and social action skills in a peer-led environ-ment in order to become catalysts for change and to educate/ enlighten fellow peers about relevant issues impacting youth.

ARTISTIC DEVELOPMENT Youth learn to articulate their ex-periences and express their creativity through fine arts instruc-tion, multimedia production, and performing arts. Includes the literacy programs Hear This school-based Literacy Program and Hampton Roads Youth Poets (HRYP) and music program.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL WELLBEING Youth develop confidence and self-awareness to help manage emotions, build healthy relationships, and feel empathy. Young people cultivate their voices, they understand, respect and appreciation differences (uniqueness).

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT & DEVELOPMENT

Youth devel-op awareness and understanding of community issues, prob-lems, and resources and are equipped with the knowledge and understanding of how to use their power and influence to bring about positive change, create solutions, while sharing their voice and experiences with others.
